2. Annual Parish Council Meeting Items

- a) Acceptance of Office forms were signed by members and witnessed by AM.
- b) <u>Election of Chairman</u> NS was proposed by GN, seconded by DL, unanimously elected.
- c) <u>Election of Vice-Chairman</u> DL was proposed by NS, seconded by PB, unanimously elected.
- d) Adoption of General Powers of Competence it was unanimously **agreed** to adopt General Powers of Competence, the legal conditions having been met.
- e) Co-option of Michael Blake was unanimously agreed and acceptance of office signed.
- f) Review and approval of standing orders, policies and procedures the full set of policies was **approved**. AM reported that the updated website accessibility statement is outstanding due to issues found in testing, now with the supplier.
- g) Reminder to members to submit Register of Interests was noted.
- h) Appointment of representatives DL agreed to continue as Village Hall Committee rep. and GN as Armed Forces Champion. No Norfolk ALC rep. was found.

### 3. Public Forum

- a) County Councillor Report LH presented considerations and aspirations for Postwick Park and Ride, which were debated with great interest. She also explained the funding and rationale behind the County Council's proposal to operate electric vehicle charging points at the Village Hall. This is primarily to provide an amenity rather than make a profit. There will be no charge to the Village Hall or Parish Council. Item 10f refers.
- b) <u>District Councillor Report</u> GN was pleased to have held his seat in the Marshes Ward, and thanked people for their support. He is looking forward to serving in a new political situation with no one party in overall control at Broadland District Council. The Council's AGM will be held in the new Horizon building on 25th May.
- c) <u>Tree Wardens' Report -</u> Tree wardens reported that 42 tree wardens now serve across Broadland. 1,831 trees were planted last year. A new Junior Tree Wardens group is being started at Rackheath School, having been unable to restart the group at Freethorpe.



#### 9. **Planning**

- c) Enforcements two open cases were noted with no further discussion.

### 10. Update on Ongoing Matters and Projects

- a) Speed Management on School Road, 85th percentile speeds were down from 27.6mph to 27.1mph on slightly lower volumes of 3,575 vehicles. On the Common at the Southwood entry, 85th percentile speeds were slightly up from 33.0 to 33.1mph on increased volumes of 20,076 vehicles. It was noted that Police have been carrying out further speed checks.
- b) Play Area Inspections no new concerns have emerged from play area inspections. National Lottery funding of £7,000 has been applied for to replace the surfacing around the swings at Freethorpe with recycled rubber mulch. It was noted that the swings may have to be closed if the surface deteriorates further.
- c) Freethorpe Village Sign work to clean and repaint is scheduled for May.

d) Allotments – no further progress.

- e) <u>Parish Nature Plan</u> was approved subject to applying JF's review comments. The plan is based on an encouraging response from 23 residents, who provided data and some great ideas. The Nature Plan will now be published and reviewed as part of the Council's policies.
- f) <u>Electronic Vehicle Charging Point</u> DL had kindly raised with Village Hall Committee. Questions were asked about costs. AM and LH confirmed that there were no costs to the Village Hall or Parish Council as Norfolk County Council will manage the service. The way in which the electricity used will be refunded to the Village Hall to be clarified. **ACTION AM**
- g) <u>Wickhampton Pond</u> PB kindly provided some relevant past papers, including assumption of ownership in minutes of 15/06/2009; contact to be made with the Vicar regarding the pond in minutes of 12/09/2009; and agreement to register the pond in minutes of 15/11/2010 09/05/2011. Further evidence of assumed ownership to be sent to AM. **ACTION ALL**
- h) Rampant Horse PC advised that the Community Interest Company has not been set up yet. It would be helpful to know when the pub is expected to go up for sale and the asking price. Questions to be raised with Broadland District Council.
