## Norfolk County Council (Freethorpe) (Emergency Notice) Temporary Traffic Restriction 2022 Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to burst water main repairs the use by vehicles of the Low Road from 44m south of its junction with Church Road for 20m southwards in the PARISH OF FREETHORPE will be temporarily prohibited from 30<sup>th</sup> September to 6<sup>th</sup> October 2022 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 7 days within the period. If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 21 days.

Alternative route is via: Church Road, Mill Road, Low Road (Freethorpe, Halvergate).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order)

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
